### Family Boundaries

*Young people thrive better with clearly defined boundaries.*

*Parents need to set clear rules and consequences for their children's behavior and monitor their whereabouts. Parents, discuss appropriate boundaries, reach an agreement and stand united. Renegotiate family rules with teenagers so they're developmentally appropriate but know that even 18 year olds still need boundaries. Use discipline to teach, not to punish. Educate young people in how to set boundaries for themselves. When you see young people in inappropriate places, take responsibility to ask them if their parents know where they are.*
