

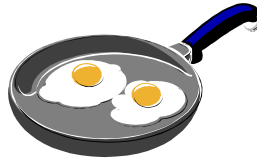

Call to Action on Water Rights Filings – Deadline has been extended to 17 Jan. 2007

Lehi City, in cooperation with the cities of Highland, Alpine, American Fork, Cedar Hills, Pleasant Grove, and Saratoga Springs is actively initiating a protest action against multiple filings recently made by Jordan Valley Water Conservancy District to place a number of new water supply wells in North Utah County. In order to make this protest action successful, the cities need the help of as many people as possible including city employees, your friends, and neighbors. This is not the first time this type of action has been required. In 1996, they also made an attempt to develop a number of deep water wells, principally in Lehi City and Highland City. At that time a number of North Utah County municipalities, supported by residents, successfully arose to actively protest this action. Take a similar action.

Your protest would need to be filed in writing to the State Engineers office no later than January 17, 2007. See attachments.
