With the down turn in the economy, many local residents are choosing to not pay their medical bills. Intermountain Healthcare Facilities are encouraging patients to utilize "Charity Care" for financial difficulties and emergencies. You can even see how much a procedure will cost by pre-qualifying. If someone is helping pay for your medical bills, be sure they let the hospital know. The bill may then qualify for a 20% discount (this includes Bishops, organizations, etc.).
