

## **Lehi City Cemetery Ordinances and Regulations**

In order for Lehi City Cemetery staff to maintain a respectful and aesthetically pleasing environment for our patrons, we have set forth guidelines that are in accordance with our Cemetery ordinances.

1. No planting of any tree or shrub
2. No planting of flowers without permission from Cemetery Sexton
2. All Flowers and decorations will be removed after seven days, weather permitting
3. Permanent decorations- shepherd hooks, are allowed only when drilled within the apron of the Headstone and must be approved by the Sexton or a Cemetery Staff member. Other décor will only be allowed during the Memorial Day season and Christmas Season with written notice at the Cemetery entrances for clean- up dates. All other décor will be picked up and discarded on a weekly basis for maintenance purposes.
4. No placement of Grave Marker and, or Headstone without permission of Cemetery Sexton and a setting fee.
5. Animal owners must obey the Lehi City leash laws and owners of animals who bring their pets into the Cemetery property ,must leave their animals on their leash at all times. They are not allowed onto the planted areas of the Cemetery. The owner is also responsible to clean up after the animal. It is against Lehi City law for an animal to urinate or defecate on a burials site, a marker or a headstone.
6. No private mowing or digging
7. For the Safety of our Patrons and Guests, children are to be closely monitored by parents/guardians to prevent accidents or injuries. The City will not be held accountable for incident.

### **Lost and Found Items**

Any items lost or found at the Cemetery facilities should be taken to the Police Station.

Pre-existing Trees and or Shrubs that block the watering system and/or are in the way of maintenance can and will be removed at the City's discretion.
