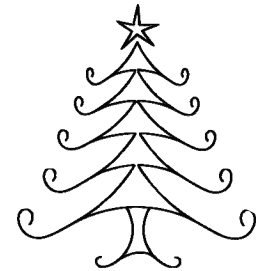

- Picture ID of yourself.
- ID for all children for whom you are applying. This can be original or certified copies of birth certificates, baptismal papers, or school ID. Whatever you bring must show a date of birth.
- Income Verification: Please bring proof of your income from the last 30 days. This should be your last two current pay stubs or a letter from your employer stating your monthly income. If you are receiving other assistance such as Medicaid, housing, or help from your church, family, etc., you must bring proof of that.
- Proof of current address with your name on it - a bill or lease agreement.
- Children's Information: Come prepared to report your children's birth dates, clothing sizes, shoe sizes, and the items they need most for Christmas.

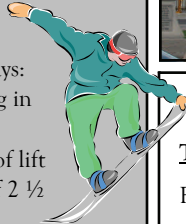
