## Mayor's Message

It is an exciting time to be living in Lehi. As we all know, the City is growing at an exceptional rate. The City's growth brings with it exciting new opportunities, but it also brings the need for new and updated infrastructure. In the last three years, Lehi has seen the opening or reconstruction of four major roads: Pioneer Crossing, Timpanogos Highway, Lehi Main Street, and 2100 North. Each of these roads are important major east-west collectors.

On Friday, August 9, Lehi celebrated the opening of the connection of 2300 West to the Thanksgiving Point area. This project has been on the City's master transportation plan since 1980, and the connection was finally constructed thanks to federal and local funding. 2300 West is a major north-south collector, and it now connects all of West Lehi with the Thanksgiving Point area. As exciting as the opening of this section of 2300 West is, the project is still in progress. 2300 West will eventually include an overpass above I-15, connecting with Timpanogos Highway at Triumph Boulevard.

It has been a great experience to be a part of the completion of these exciting projects. It is especially gratifying to see the direct benefit that these projects have had in our community. I encourage everyone to take a drive on these new roads, take your time, watch the speed limit, and enjoy the views!
