Family Week kicks off on Sunday, November 18, at 7 p.m. with a free family concert at Willowcreek Middle School. The program will include music from Vocal Point, Lehi Children’s Choir, and Vivaldi Quartet.

The week will conclude on Saturday, November 24, with a parade on Main Street that begins at 4 p.m. at Lehi High School and will end at 100 West Main. The Tree Lighting ceremony will begin immediately following the parade at 99 West Main Street. Hot chocolate, cookies and other festivities are planned for the tree lighting. Families can then go to the Legacy Center and enjoy a free family dance from 6- 10 p.m.

“This has been a fun tradition in the community for many years,” said Mayor Bert Wilson. “It’s a great way to kick off the holiday season.”
