This position will assist in supervising full-time and part-time staff.

**MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:** Graduation from high school plus six years of progressively responsible experience in the maintenance, upkeep, and beautification of turf, parks, facilities and related environs; OR, an equivalent combination of education and experience.

Must have a valid Utah State Commercial Driver's License (CDL); ability to lift a minimum of 50 pounds; ability to communicate verbally and in writing; skilled in operating various types of general hand tools and light equipment such as shovels, picks, rakes, wire tracers, volt meters, drills, saws; general maintenance equipment including front end loader, tractor, backhoe, etc.; basic mechanics, electrical; plumbing operations, basic carpentry.

Ability to develop effective working relationships with supervisor, subordinates and the public; will be required to pass a drug test and back ground check.
