## Mayor's Message The State of Lehi City

Looking back over 2013, I am impressed with all that Lehi City has accomplished. Although the City experienced some growing pains, Lehi is poised to continue to develop into one of Utah's premier locations to live and work. As we prepare to meet the challenges and opportunities that lay ahead, I would like to take a moment to look back at some of the significant things that happened in 2013:

**Economic and Community Development.** Lehi remains at the forefront of commercial and residential development in Utah.

Lehi continued to be a destination location for commercial expansion and relocation, welcoming Blender Bottle, MoneyDesktop, Vivint, and MultiView, just to name a few. Xactware is almost complete with its new building near Traverse Mountain, and Adobe broke ground on phase II of development. We also saw continued growth in retail and restaurants, with The Outlets at Traverse Mountain breaking ground on phase II of its development. Lehi was also recognized as second in the state in residential construction. No matter which way you look at it, Lehi has become the heart of growth along the Wasatch Front.

**New Infrastructure.** Lehi City recognizes the importance of developing the infrastructure necessary to sustain its growth. As one of the fastest growing cities in one of the driest states in the country, Lehi City understands the importance of the development and maintenance of its water resources. To that end, the City made several improvements to culinary and pressurized irrigation wells. The City also completed the 2300 West Road project, connecting the neighborhoods along 2100 North with Thanksgiving Point. The Water Division is on schedule to clean the sewer collection system in less than two years, and the Streets Division upgraded all City traffic signals with new LED lights. The City also moved forward with its plan to build a new fire station. As Lehi continues to grow, the City is committed to ensuring that we have the infrastructure to maintain our excellent quality of life.

**Community and Recreation Improvement.** One of the best parts about living in Lehi is our excellent communities and recreational facilities. The City took some major steps forward in ensuring that Lehi residents can continue to enjoy an excellent quality of life. The City completed the aesthetic improvements along Main Street, with beautiful water features and other landscape improvements. The City also completed the renovation of the Justice Court, the Library entrance, and the Senior Center entrance. On a more somber note, the City selected a beautiful sculpture to highlight the new infant cemetery that is under construction. Lehi also moved forward with the design process for "Peck Park", a 72-acre plot of land that the City will own beginning in 2016. This process included holding two public design workshops, as well as acquiring more than 72,000 cubic yards of nutrient rich soil for future development.

**Budget Stability and Transparency.** Lehi continues to maintain a stable budget, as well as a healthy rainy day fund to prepare for any future economic downturns. The City is also committed to financial transparency, as it was one of only a handful of Utah cities to receive the Government Finance Officer Association's awards for its Budget, Comprehensive Annual Financial Review, and Popular Annual Financial Report.

I am always pleased to reflect on the great things that Lehi has accomplished, but I am most impressed with our amazing residents that continue to preserve Lehi as a vibrant, family-friendly community. I am confident that as we work together, Lehi is poised for even greater things to come!



## UCHD offers help with Kindergarten Registration

Do you have a child going into kindergarten in the fall? To register them, you will need to have a copy of their birth certificate and have their vaccinations up-to-date. The Utah County Health Department (UCHD) can help! Copies of birth certificates can be obtained from our offices in Provo (151 South University Ave) or American Fork (599 South 500 East), or by going online to [www.UtahCountyHealth.org](http://www.UtahCountyHealth.org) and clicking on "Birth/Death Certificates."

The UCHD can also look up vaccination records (medical provider participation required). If you need immunizations, we provide all childhood vaccinations. We take most insurances, as well as provide low cost Vaccine for Children (VFC) Program vaccines (availability based on income). UCHD will have some additional community clinics as well (see website for dates, times and locations). For help or details, see our web site or call 801-851-7000.

## ASD "Child Find"

The Alpine School District Department of Special Education is attempting to contact persons with disabilities between the ages of birth and twenty-one in compliance with the Federal law, which mandates the provision of free educational programs and/or services for such persons. If a child is having significant difficulty with vision, hearing, speech, behavior, is experiencing slow development untypical for his/her age, physical impairments, or learning difficulty, he/she may be a child with a disability.

If you know of any child whom you feel might qualify for these services, including students suspected of having a disability even through they are advancing from grade to grade, in a private school, homeless, or migrant, please contact the principal of your school or the Special Education office of Alpine School District at 801-610-8410.

If you are the parent of a child with an IEP enrolled in a public school, we are required by Utah State Code to inform you of the availability of a scholarship to attend a private school through the Carson Smith Scholarship Program.
