MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from high school or equivalent; Commercial Driver's License (CDL) **preferred; Some knowledge** of the design, adjustment, operation, maintenance, and repair of diversified mechanical and electrical equipment including light, medium, and heavy gasoline and diesel engines; materials and tools used in equipment maintenance; the safety practices required by state and other laws; **Ability** to read and interpret maintenance manuals, parts books, and mechanical drawings; diagnose complex and non-routine mechanical and electrical defects and problems and determine parts and adjustments necessary to repair equipment; communicate effectively, verbally, and in writing; establish and maintain effective working relationships with employees of all departments; will be required to pass a drug test and back ground check.
