Lead Building Inspector

STATUS: Full-Time with benefits (health, dental, vision, life, retirement, paid leave, etc.)

DEPARTMENT: Building Inspections Division, Community Development Department

JOB SUMMARY: Under the direct supervision of the Chief Building Official, performs a variety of **lead worker and technical duties** related to conducting site inspections on residential, commercial and industrial buildings to assure conformity with established city and state uniform building codes; may assist with examining plans as needed. This position will also provide supervision to Building Inspectors.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Graduation from high school plus two (2) years of specialized training in engineering methods and practices related to testing and compliance provided through technical college, professional workshops or university studies; AND five (5) years of responsible experience related to above duties ; one (1) year of which must have been in a lead or supervisory capacity OR an equivalent combination of education or experience.

Applicants must be an I.C.C., and/or State of Utah Certified Inspector in all **five** areas of inspection specialization (plan review, plumbing, electrical, mechanical, building, or combination dwelling). Candidates must also possess a valid Utah Driver's license.

APPLICATIONS: Each applicant is required to turn in a Lehi City application, a separate resume, and copies of any applicable certifications to Human Resources (2nd Floor of City Hall) or electronically to apply@lehi-ut.gov . Only applications from candidates that meet the above requirements and qualifications will be accepted and considered.
