JOB SUMMARY: Performs a variety of **full performance level skilled and semi-skilled duties** related to the application of chemicals to plants, trees, and grass to enhance plant growth and control weeds and pests; specializes in pesticide application and control; primarily responsible for eliminating or inhibiting the growth of unwanted vegetation, and for controlling rodent and insect problems in parks, drainage ditches, culverts, public roads, rights-of-way, and buildings; maintains and monitors the pest control programs, to include bats, bees and rodents in compliance with EPA, OSHA, and State and Federal Regulations; supervises the construction, installation, maintenance, upkeep and repair of irrigation systems associated with recreation facilities, parks, grounds and general environments; performs other maintenance and duties as related to Parks, Buildings and Cemetery operations.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Graduation from high school plus four (4) years of experience in selecting correct chemicals, following application rates for weed, pest control, and pre-emergent; maintenance, upkeep, and beautification of turf, parks, facilities and related environs or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Possess a current Utah State Pesticide License; must obtain a valid Utah State Commercial Driver's License (CDL) upon hire. The ability to lift a minimum of 50 pounds; ability to communicate verbally and in writing; skilled in operating and maintaining equipment such as backhoe, loader, dump truck, mowers, tractor, power over seeders, aerators, thatchers, welders, trimmers, etc. The ability to develop effective working relationships with supervisor, subordinates and the public; will be required to pass a drug test and back ground check.
