JOB SUMMARY: Performs a variety of skilled and semi-skilled duties related to the construction, installation, maintenance, upkeep and repair of recreational facilities, parks, grounds and city buildings.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Graduation from high school plus four years of experience in caring for buildings and grounds with a wide range of skills; including but not limited to carpentry, plumbing, routine electrical wiring, routine heating systems, painting, general landscaping and custodial work; must obtain a valid Utah State Commercial Driver License (CDL) upon hire; ability to lift a minimum of 50 pounds; ability to communicate verbally and in writing; skilled in operating and maintaining maintenance equipment such as mowers, chain saws, pruning equipment, backhoe, loaders and hand tools; ability to develop effective working relationships with supervisor, subordinates and the public; will be required to pass a drug test and back ground check.
