JOB SUMMARY: Under the direction of the Power System Planner, manages the operation of the engineering and electrical systems within the city. To design power system facilities and equipment, coordinate construction, operation, and maintenance of electric power generating, substations, transmission lines, and distribution systems and equipment as well as conducts power system designs that are development related.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Bachelor's degree from an accredited college in civil engineering or electrical engineering AND minimum of two (2) years full time progressively responsible paid work experience sufficient to demonstrate possession of the knowledge and skills listed for this position OR equivalent combination of education and full-time work experience. Must possess a valid driver license--a valid Utah Driver License must be obtained within 60 days of hire and be maintained throughout employment.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: Minimum of 3-5 years of full-time paid work experience; possess Engineer-in-Training or Professional Engineer certification from the State of Utah. Applicants who possess EIT or PE certification from another jurisdiction must become certified in the State of Utah within six (6) months of employment.
