JOB SUMMARY: Performs a variety of **highly-skilled journey level technician** and with supervisory responsibilities in installation, testing, maintenance, and repairs of electrical systems, substations and various other electrical facilities.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Graduation from high school; AND successful completion of application apprenticeship from IPSA or other DOL-registered apprenticeship program; AND at least two (2) years of journey level experience as a Substation Technician. Current driver's license; and the ability to perform heavy physical labor, lifting up to 100 pounds. CDL License and CPR Certification preferred.

Employees of this class may be subject to on-call status. This position is subject to Lehi City residency requirements and is required to reside within a 20-minute response time of the City Administrative Offices as determined by the City's G.I.S. calculations.

All applicants will be required to pass a drug test and background check.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: **Advanced knowledge** of electrical theory and application including operations, functions, and terminology; electrical installation, maintenance, and repair techniques; **advanced knowledge of** the occupational hazards and safety precautions of substation construction and maintenance work (APPA, OSHA); hazards common to heavy equipment operation. **Ability to** perform heavy physical labor; communicate effectively, both verbally and in writing; tolerate weather extremes in the work environment.
