LEHI COMMUNITY NEEDS SURVEY NOW AVAILABLE

City seeks Opinions Regarding Housing and Community Development Needs

Lehi, Utah | April 17, 2014 – Lehi City’s population has been officially declared as greater than 50,000. As such, the city will now be administering federal funds under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The CDBG Program provides funds to communities for activities like affordable housing, health and human services for at risk populations, and infrastructure improvements in qualifying areas of the City.

To obtain feedback about current housing and community development needs and services, a community survey has been created. The survey is anonymous, takes only a few minutes to complete, and all responses are confidential. The survey results will help Lehi City determine community development and housing needs for HUD’s Consolidated Plan.
