**JOB SUMMARY:** Performs a variety of skilled duties and semi-skilled duties related to managing and maintaining pressure irrigation flows and schedules.

Assists in providing for the maintenance, installation and repair of program facilities; monitors water flows; manages operation of pump stations.

Prepares irrigation ditches; lays pipe; builds head gates; prepares and maintains water flow schedules' confers with other water agencies.

Locates and marks and properly identifies underground irrigation lines on request of contractors and utility owners. Takes field measurements on irrigation valves; fire hydrants; and mainlines. Locates and brings irrigation valves to grade.

**MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:** High School graduate; Experience or technical training in water works, equipment operations, construction or closely related area is helpful. Must obtain CDL license within three (3) months of hiring.

Considerable knowledge of underground water lines, equipment placement, pipe burial depths, manhole locations, etc. Must be able to read and interpret maps and distinguish when the map may not be complete or accurate.

Must be able to learn how to operate a variety of specialized locating equipment and know when the equipment is not calibrated or operating correctly.

Must be self-motivated and able to organize, prioritize and get the job done. Must be comfortable in working alone and working extended hours if necessary to insure that all water and waste water facilities are properly and accurately placed and operating properly. Must be able to keep accurate records and prepare a report as directed. Must have excellent people and communication skills and the ability to exercise proper judgment and fairness when working with angry or confused contractor.

must be able to lift 50-75 pounds; must be willing to work on-call and 24 hour standby;
