

5' or less Parkstrip Width Acceptable Species and Varieties

All residential installations require a permit before planting in any park strip.

All trees must be single trunk formed . No multi-stemmed trees are allows in a park strip. No weeping formed trees allowed in park strips.

Proper tree installation directions will be provided with all planting permits.

*See placement and planting ordinance restrictions criteria below.

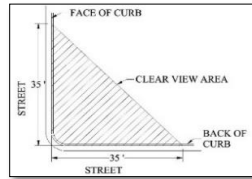

***The site chosen for planting shall follow the below criteria per Lehi City Design Standards:**

- Never plant directly under power lines
- 5' from water meter and/or utility box
- 10' from fire hydrant
- 35' from stop signs
- 35' from a street intersection. -->
- 20' from utility pole and/or light
- 10' from a Power Transformer
- Any tree located on private property (not in park strip) must be planted 4' away from a public sidewalk



- THERE IS NO GUARANTEE THAT SIDEWALK DAMAGE WILL NOT OCCUR IN THE FUTURE.
- PRUNING STRUCTURE WILL NEED TO BEGIN AT 3 YEARS FROM PLANTING TO ENCOURAGE CLEARANCE AND STRONG STRUCTURE.
