

**LEHI CITY PLANNING COMMISSION WORK SESSION**

Minute from the Lehi City Planning Commission Work Session held on Thursday, April 7, 2011 in the Lehi City Planning Dept. conference room.

**1. CRSA discussion of the Lehi City General Plan update.**

Kelly Gillman and Donald Buaku with CRSA made the presentation – an update of the information from the public workshops and survey responses. There have been 255 online and over 250 hard copy surveys – over 500 surveys total. They have never had such a large number of surveys. The survey will remain on line until April 15, 2011 unless extended. There have been 992 website visits, 17 facebook friends, and 13 map ideas. CRSA distributed hard copies and went over a presentation showing the results of the survey thus far.

CRSA also provided two other memorandums: a public outreach results summary and draft vision statements. A general discussion was held, and comments were forwarded to CRSA. They asked the Commission to review the two documents and to provide feedback. Also, a discussion will be held at the next Planning Commission meeting on April 28, 2011 where the vision will be discussed.

A discussion was also held regarding the joint work session with the City Council scheduled for May. It was decided that the Planning Commission would like to come forward with a recommendation on the vision to the City Council.

Brad Kennison discussed the possibility of the jurisdictional transfer of Main Street from UDOT to Lehi City. The City Council directed staff to submit a letter of intent to UDOT. There is a possibility that some of the funds provided by UDOT with this transfer could be used to complete some of the Downtown Revitalization plan.

*Derek Byrne moved to direct staff to look at the Sign ordinance regarding LED signs in Lehi City and to bring back options. Second by Carolyn Nelson.*

*Kordel Braley asked to specify what specifically Derek Byrne is concerned with.*

*Derek Byrne stated he feels LED signs should not be permitted, unless it is a community sign.*

*A general discussion was held regarding LED signage in the City.*

*Motion carried unanimous.*

*Carolyn Player moved to adjourn. Second by Marilyn Schiess. Motion carried unanimous.*
