



# Round-Up Parade Handbook

## Parade Days and Hours

All parades begin at Wines Park on 600 North 100 East and end at Lehi High School at 500 East 200 North.

- **Miniature Float Parade - Friday, June 23, 2023, at 6 p.m.**
  - The theme is "The Magic in Ordinary Days..." This parade is open to miniature floats, and other children's entries, and invited bands.
  - Judging for miniature floats will take place at 2 p.m.
- **Grand Parade – Saturday, June 24, 2023, at 10 a.m.**
  - *This parade is open to a limited number of entries.*
  - Judging of mammoth floats will take place at 9 a.m. All floats must be lined up by 9 a.m.

## Online Application Process

**The application deadline is June 2, 2023. No applications will be accepted after that time.** You will be notified by email as to your acceptance the week of June 4-10. **FILLING OUT APPLICATION DOES NOT GUARANTEE ENTRANCE IN PARADE.** The lineup will be emailed to you the week prior to the parade.

## Fees

There is a \$100 fee for commercial entries. Exceptions may be made for Round-Up event sponsors. Payment is due June 16. If payment is not made by that date, the entry will be cancelled. No refunds are available on these fees. Fees can be paid 1) online 2) in person at City Hall, 153 North 100 East, or 3) by mail, 153 North 100 East, Lehi UT 84043. Proof of payment may be required.

## Rules

All rules will be strictly enforced. Failure to obey any of the above rules may result in your entry being escorted from the parade route and will jeopardize your eligibility for future years. Lehi agrees not to and shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, gender, age, national origin (ancestry), disability, marital status, sexual orientation, or military status, in any of its applicable activities in violation of federal, state or local laws.

- The decision of the Round-Up Committee concerning acceptance of any entry into the parade will be final.
- The Round-Up Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry into the parade if, in its sole judgment, it determines that the entry is controversial or unlawful or has little entertainment value.
- All entries must be driven by an adult 21 years of age or older, with a current driver's license. Entries must be able to maneuver turns at corners. Amplified sound must be approved beforehand.
- NO CANDY/TOYS/FLIERS, ETC. may be thrown from floats or vehicles.
  - Candy / Toys / Fliers, etc. may be thrown by "walkers" (parade participants on foot) from either side of the parade route. Individuals walking beside an entry must take great care to ensure the safety of themselves and others.
- Lehi City's liability insurance does not cover your parade entry in the event of injury, death, theft, fire, etc. that may be caused as a result of your negligence. Safety and liability concerns and operation of your entry and participants is your sole responsibility. Prior to the parade, the Lehi City Risk Manager will conduct a walk through to ensure that all entries have taken proper safety precautions. Entrants are required to comply with the Risk Manager's requests or leave the event without receiving a refund or payment for performance.
- The Lehi Round-Up Committee reserves the right to place parade entries in any order they deem necessary.
- No campaigning, positive or negative, is allowed by parade participants. The Lehi Round-Up is nonpartisan and supports no candidates or elected officials of any party. Active campaigning during the parade detracts from the purposes of the parade. Each year, Lehi City's Mayor and City Council are invited to participate in the Grand Parade in recognition of the offices each holds and for the services they have rendered, but not to give them an opportunity to campaign.

- No candidate participating in the parade or their supporter for election or re-election may: display or distribute any materials or voice or transmit audio materials and information in support for or against theirs or another's candidacy.
- No parade entry or persons participating or associated with a parade entry may campaign for a candidate, an elected official currently serving, or a special interest group's platform or causes by displaying or distributing any materials or voice or transmit audio materials and information that promotes or supports a political candidate, currently serving elected official, or a special interest group's cause. Parade entries and their sponsoring organization and persons participating with each entry are to only promote the annual Grand Parade theme and the vision of the Lehi Round-Up from each entry.
- No demonstrating or protesting is allowed by parade entries or entry participants.
- If you are asked to leave the parade route by any parade official or police officer for any inappropriate behavior or for not following parade standards, you will do so. If anyone in your organization fails to leave when asked by an official, your entire entry will be dismissed from the parade route and will jeopardize your eligibility for participation in future Lehi Roundup parades.
- The Parade Committee may reject any entry at its sole discretion that are deemed controversial, political, unlawful, unsafe, or otherwise considered to be inconsistent with the standards or the purposes of the Lehi Round-Up Parade. All parade entries must be entertaining. Acceptable entries include things such as a float, a band, or other entry that is consistent with the Lehi Round-Up Celebration theme.
- All Dance groups, Cheerleading groups, School groups, and Clubs will be required to walk and perform. Your group will NOT be allowed to ride in any vehicle. Please be sure if your group has a routine to perform that it is designed to permit constant forward movement of the parade. No stopping or holding up traffic will be permitted. If your group causes parade gaps, you will be escorted from the parade route and your eligibility for participation in future Lehi Roundup parades will be jeopardized.
- Groups that need a sound system for music will be allowed one small, motorized vehicle per entry. This must be approved beforehand. The vehicle may not be anything larger than a 4- wheeler or golf-cart to carry your sound system. These must be driven by an adult 18 years or older.
- Marching Bands are not allowed motorized support vehicles.
- No water is to be thrown from the parade route.
