Literacy Center

Our spring after-school session began last month and will continue through May 14, 2026. Our after-school classes offer **reading classes for Lehi students in K through 4th grade** and **math classes for Lehi students in 1st through 4th grade**. Classes are 45 min twice a week, Mon/Wed OR Tues/Thurs at 4 p.m. & 5 p.m.

The **Summer Reading & Math Session** will run from June 1 through July 23. Assessment and registration appointments are required for the summer session. An appointment scheduler for assessments will be available on May 4 on our website. Parents can schedule a time from May 18 to May 20 for student assessment and registration for new students. Class times for the Summer Session are 9 a.m., 10 a.m., 11 a.m., and 12 p.m.

Our next **ABC Pre-K session will be in the fall of 2026**; watch our Facebook page & website for more details. This program is a kindergarten readiness program for 4-year-old students. Classes are 2 hours twice a week, Mon/Wed OR Tues/Thurs, from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Eligible students must be 4 years old as of September 1, 2026, and may only attend one session.
