MAYOR'S MESSAGE

As we move into the warmer months, I want to take a moment to talk about something that affects all of us, water.

This year, Utah experienced record low snowpack, and we are now seeing the effects of that in the form of ongoing drought conditions. While water may still

feel abundant in our day-to-day lives, the reality is that it is a limited resource that we all share and must manage carefully.

To help protect our water supply, the City is implementing Phase II of our water conservation plan. Under these guidelines, residents should not irrigate on consecutive days and should limit watering to two days per week, with at least 48 hours between irrigation cycles. These measures are designed to stretch our supply while still supporting responsible landscape care.

I also want residents to know that the City is taking this challenge seriously and doing our part alongside you. Lehi City follows the same Water Shortage Management Plan and weekly watering guidance as our residents. You may notice that some of our parks have grass that appears brown or stressed. This is a direct result of the drought conditions and our commitment to follow the same conservation standards. We are using smart irrigation controllers to ensure we are making the most efficient use of the water we are allowed.

As a resident of this community myself, I try to be mindful of my own water use and make choices that support the greater good. Being a good neighbor means looking beyond our individual needs and doing what is best for the community as a whole. Small efforts, when taken together, can make a meaningful difference.

I encourage each of you to take a moment to evaluate your own water use and find simple ways to conserve. Whether it's adjusting your sprinkler schedule, fixing leaks, or reducing outdoor watering, every action helps.

We all have a role to play in protecting this vital resource. By working together, we can help ensure our community remains strong, resilient, and prepared for the future.

WATER RESTRICTIONS

Lehi City is currently in Phase II water restrictions, and compliance is required. Outdoor watering is limited to **no more than two days per week**, and **irrigation on consecutive days is not permitted.**

Residents **must allow at least 48 hours between watering cycles** to help protect our limited water supply.

IMPORTANT WATER REMINDERS

Secondary water (pressurized irrigation) is untreated water designated for outdoor irrigation.

Drinking or playing in irrigation water can pose a health risk, as it may contain harmful bacteria.

Irrigation water **should not be used** for bounce houses, pools, slip-n-slides, water tables, etc.

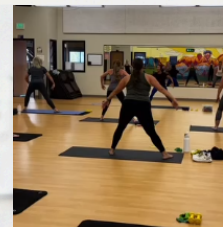
