

Lehi City's Unacceptable Public Street Tree List

The following species are **NOT** allowed to be planted in any park strip in Lehi.

These trees exhibit characteristics including but not limited to: Undesirable root systems, extreme insect or disease susceptibility, soft or brittle wood, fruit, line of site restrictions, or provide a diverse urban canopy.

Such problems often lead to excessive maintenance costs, hazards to other trees and potential public safety hazards.

All species of the following trees:

Ash— All cultivars of *Fraxinus*

Birch— All cultivars of *Betulus*

Boxelder— All cultivars of *Acer negundo*

Cottonwoods/Aspens/Poplars— All cultivars of *Populus* species

Elm Siberian—*Ulmus pumila*

Evergreens/Conifers -All cultivars/varieties

Flowering Pear— All cultivars of *Pyrus calleryana*

Fruit Bearing Trees -All cultivars/varieties

Fruitless Mulberry—*Morus alba*

Honeylocust— All cultivars of *Gledestia* sp. (acceptable in strips 10' or wider)

London Plane Tree -*Plantanus x acerifolia* (acceptable in strips 10' or wider)

Maple -Freeman— All cultivars of *Acer x freemanii*

Maple Red—All cultivars of *Acer rubrum*

Maple, Silver—*Acer saccharinum*

Maple Sugar— All cultivars of *Acer Saccharum*

Clump Formed Trees—Numerous Species

Purple Robe Locust - *Robinia pseudoacacia*

Russian Olive—*Elaeagnus angustifolia*

Saltcedars—*Tamarix*

Tree of Heaven—*Alianthus altissima*

Umbrella Catalpa—*Catalpa bignonioides* 'Nana'

Weeping Formed Trees—Numerous Species

Willows— All cultivars of *Sali*

Planting Restrictions

- Plant adjacent to powerlines and not directly under them.
- 5' from culinary or PI water meters or a utility box - Includes shrubbery. These may be located on private property and not located within the park strip area.
- 10' from fire hydrant- Includes shrubbery
- 35' from stop signs, school zones warning lights or signs, pedestrians sign
- 5' from a service walk or driveway
- 40' from an intersection with traffic lights
- Within 35' of the clear view triangle at intersections. Includes shrubbery over 24" at maturity.
- 10' from a Power Transformer – Includes shrubbery
- Any tree located on private property (not in the park strip) must be planted 4' away from a public sidewalk or trail



Lehi Community Forestry Ordinances in Chapter 35 pertains to all vegetation within the Right of Way areas.

All trees planted within a park strip require a preapproved permit before installation by city ordinance.

The permit is free
