In 1997, Hesther Rippy learned that nearly 29% of Lehi City elementary school children were reading below grade level. Inspired by the notion of helping young people achieve their full potential, Hesther and her husband, Bill, envisioned a center where children and their parents could come for assistance in learning to read.

Today, students, trained teaching staff and volunteers have access to grade level reading materials, and computer stations with educational software in an inviting atmosphere.

## ABC Program

### Kindergarten Preparation

Our morning ABC Program is a kindergarten readiness program that focuses on letter and sound recognition, phonemic awareness, early writing and social skills.

\* ABC students attend one session before they begin kindergarten.

**Eligible students must be 4 years old on or before September 1 the year prior to kindergarten**

**Classes are Monday & Wednesday OR Tuesday & Thursday  
9:30 am to 11:30 am**

**Fall Session: August – December  
Spring Session: January – May**

## OUR PROGRAMS

All programs are available to Lehi residents K-4th grade at no cost. Classes are designed to provide an exciting and instructional environment where fun and learning go hand in hand.

The mission of the Literacy Center is to provide effective small group reading and math literacy classes to help children in the Lehi community thrive in society. The Center also offers meaningful service opportunities for community volunteers.

## Volunteer Program

Volunteers come 2x a week for one hour

**Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday  
3 pm, 4 pm, 5 pm  
Summer 9 am, 10 am, 11 am and 12 noon**

Each volunteer is placed with a teacher to assist in helping students.  
7th grade through adults are eligible.



## After-School Program



### Reading & Math Classes

Our after-school program offers reading and math classes for Lehi students K - 4th grade.

#### READING GROUPS/BOOK CLUBS (K-4th Graders)

- Early reading, phonics-based instruction
- Long vowel sounds
- Blending and decoding
- Guided chapter book reading
- Small groups working on comprehension and fluency

#### MATH GROUPS (1st-4th Graders)

- Addition, subtraction, multiplication, division
- Fractions, money, and math applications

**Classes are 45 minutes, twice a week,  
Monday & Wednesday OR Tuesday & Thursday  
3 pm, 4 pm, & 5 pm  
Summer Session 9 am, 10 am, 11 am & 12 noon**

**Fall Session: September – November  
Winter Session: December – February  
Spring Session: March – May  
Summer Session: June – July**
