



Mayor Johnson's Farewell Message



On December 31st, the remarkable opportunity I have had to serve our city came to a close. Throughout my life, I've never shied away from hard work, truthfully, I've always welcomed it. That never changed during my time as your mayor. I have never hesitated to build, to push forward, and to seek progress for this place we call home. I won't apologize for that spirit; it is part of who I am and why I chose to serve.

I consider myself fortunate to have served alongside thoughtful and dedicated council members who were willing to make tough decisions and support the efforts needed to strengthen our community and make us one of the financially strongest in our state.

I was asked to provide a list of significant milestones that have occurred during my administration and with a bit of help, the following list has been compiled. This partial list serves as a testament of what WE have collectively achieved together.

Milestones During My Tenure

2018–2020: Building the Foundation

- 2018: Began a comprehensive analysis of Lehi's future transportation and transit needs. This work continues to guide our long-term planning as the city moves toward build-out.
- 2019: Passed and enacted the Tobacco-21 ordinance, making Lehi the first city in Utah to raise the minimum age for purchasing tobacco and e-cigarette products to 21. This proactive step strengthened youth health protections and set a statewide example.
- 2020: The Joseph D. Adams Public Safety Building opened, becoming the new home for the Lehi Police Department and our Emergency Operations Center.
- 2020: Lehi City formally acquired Willow Park through a 50-year lease (with a 25-year extension option) from Utah County for only \$5 per year ensuring its long-term use for families and recreation.
- 2020: Celebrated the Golden Spoke connection, creating 30+ miles of continuous paved trail between Salt Lake and Utah Counties. Since 2018, Lehi has added 37 miles of new paved trails citywide, including 17 miles in Traverse Mountain.

2021–2023: A Connected and Thriving Community

- 2022: Construction began on the Lehi Fiber Network, and the city earned a AAA credit rating, reflecting our strong fiscal stewardship.
- 2022: Launched the annual Lehi Day of Service with Lehi Serves, uniting the community through meaningful service.
- 2023: Texas Instruments announced an \$11 billion expansion, the largest private economic investment in Utah history, bringing 800 high-tech jobs and securing Lehi's role as a leader in advanced semiconductor manufacturing.

2024–2025: Parks, Public Safety, and Open Space

- 2024: Opened the 85-acre Family Park and added several new parks between 2024–2025, including Shadow Ridge Park, the Willow Park Dog Park, Exchange Dog Park, North Ridge Park, Holbrook Farms Park, and the new Parks Facility Building.
- 2024: Partnered with Draper City to permanently conserve 900 acres on Traverse Mountain, protecting critical open space for future generations.
- 2024: Opened Fire Station 84, Lehi's fourth station, strategically located to support the rapidly growing west side and nearby medical facilities.
- 2025: Completion of the Lehi Fiber Network, providing high-speed, open-access internet citywide.
- 2025: Construction begins on Dry Creek Park and preparation begins on Mellor Rhodes Park, continuing our commitment to parks and recreation.
- 2025: Civic Center, which will be home to the new library, near completion.

As a citizen, I look forward to the future of this extraordinary place. I do so with gratitude, confidence, and a heart full of appreciation for the people who make this city what it is.

Literacy Center

The spring session of our morning ABC Pre-K Program will begin January 14 & 15, 2026 and run through May 13 & 14, 2026. Classes are 2 hours twice a week, Mon/Wed OR Tues/Thurs from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Eligible students must be 4 years old as of September 1, 2025 and may only attend one session.

Our Winter After-School Reading & Math session began in December and will run until February 14, 2026.
