Work Session

1. **Natalie Larsen – Lehi Roundup presentation**

Engineer Powell indicated that he has determined a new layout for the 300 North Road by the city streets dept.

Engineer Powell indicated that the city will need legal input and an environmental into the Wilderness Access Trail Association. The city is ready to sign a letter of with a goal and access for a joint issue with Lehi Alpine and the Patterson family.

Council member Dixon indicated that he was contacted by a citizen with concern over the 2100 North construction. The neighborhood has asked that they be informed of UDOT activities as we get the notices. It was recommended that noticing be given in the Mayor message with an update link to weekly updates that are given by UDOT; on the front page of our web site; and door hangers (need license by Lehi Municipal Code).

Council member Revill reported that Saturday night is the Miss Lehi Pageant and invited all to attend at 7:00 p.m. in the High School Auditorium.
