1. Keeping of animals for properties located within a Planned Community District must be authorized through an Area Plan. See Section 12.120 (D)(5) for requirements of keeping animals in the Planned Community District.

2. Approval of a Conditional Use Permit is required for Category Two animals in the R-1-15 and R-1-12 Districts.

* There is no defined maximum number of allowed animals/bee hives, however, animals/bee hives must be kept in good health and without creating nuisances to neighboring property owners. A kennel license is required to keep more than 2 dogs or 3 cats on any property.
