JOB SUMMARY: Performs a variety of journey level skilled duties on an assigned field crew related to the construction, installation, maintenance and repair of city culinary water systems. May operate machinery to clean storm drain systems.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Graduation from high school plus four (4) years of experience in water system operations including construction, maintenance or repair of water distribution systems. Considerable knowledge of underground water systems, equipment placement, residential service locations, easements and right-of-way specifications is necessary; must have Utah CDL license; ability to lift a minimum of 50 pounds; ability to communicate verbally and in writing; skilled in operating various types of tools and power equipment to perform essential functions; Ability to develop effective working relationships with supervisor, subordinates and the public; will be required to pass a drug test and back ground check. Must possess a valid CDL. Must be confined space certified. Must obtain relevant State Water Distribution Certification Level 3 within one year of hire.

RESPONSE TIME: Employee must reside within 20 minutes of City Offices (based on average Google Maps drive time) for on-call purposes. Employee can take up to 6 months to relocate within appropriate response time area.
