New City Logo

Represents Past, Present, & Future

The Lehi City Council adopted a new logo and style guide at its January 13 meeting. The new logo, which features a cityscape design representing several of the city's most prominent buildings, is intended to celebrate Lehi's past while representing Lehi as a vibrant, growing community.

The whole design process included a city-wide survey and focus groups to determine residents' views, several design iterations, and several color choices that ultimately resulted in a final selection by the city council.

In addition to a new logo, the style guide also includes a few department-specific logos, new patches for the police and fire departments, as well as new wraps for police and fire vehicles.
