JOB SUMMARY: Performs a variety of **full performance level skilled duties** related to the installation, preventive maintenance, upgrades to electrical distribution, wiring, lighting, conduit and electronic control systems, monitoring, troubleshooting, and repairing of various mechanical and electrical equipment in heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) systems in City buildings.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Graduation from high school plus five (5) years of progressively responsible experience relating to electric, heating, air conditioning, maintenance and repair; OR, an equivalent combination of education and experience. Must have a valid Utah State Commercial Driver's License (CDL); ability to lift a minimum of 50 pounds; ability to communicate verbally and in writing; Ability to interpret wiring diagrams, blueprints, and electrical schematics; troubleshoot and repair problems in electrical wiring and HVAC; run tests, isolate problems, replace faulty wiring, lay conduit and perform other tasks as necessary; Ability to develop effective working relationships with supervisor, subordinates and the public; will be required to pass a drug test and back ground check. Journeyman Electrician License required, with HVAC experience/credentials preferred.
