# Water Shortage Management Plan

## Phase II: Moderate Water Shortage

Due to the above average rainfall in May and the recently approved purchase of additional water, the Lehi City Water Division is updating pressurized irrigation water restrictions to Phase II: Yellow, effective May 28. See restrictions listed below).

**Lawn Watering** – Limited to two days per week according to city or county street addresses.  
 Odd-numbered addresses: Monday and Friday  
 Even-numbered addresses: Tuesday and Saturday  
 Spot-watering on Sunday

**Hard-Surface Washing** – No hard surface washing, except for health or safety reasons.

Exceptions are made for new lawns that require frequent irrigation within 30 days of installation for establishment purposes. Exceptions are also made for short cycles required for testing, inspecting, and maintaining irrigation systems.
