LEHI KICKS OFF INAUGURAL “HERITAGE DAY” BY OPENING “WALK OF FAME” City Honors Individuals who Positively Impacted Lehi History

In an effort to preserve its history and honor the individuals who helped make Lehi what it is today, Lehi is opening the “Lehi Walk of Fame.” The Walk of Fame will be located in the City’s Legacy Park in between the Legacy Center and Hutchings Museum on North Center Street.

The individuals being honored have each done amazing things for Lehi City. Among the honorees include a past Lehi County Sherriff, a long-time Main Street business owner, a past Civic Improvement Association past-president, Lehi Historical Committee Members, a past Lehi school teacher and principal, and a past Lehi Fire chief.

The Walk of Fame will be officially unveiled on Labor Day, Monday, September 1st at 2:00 pm at Legacy Park. The unveiling ceremony will include a short ceremony where Lehi founder, Bishop David Evans, will be portrayed and induct the individuals into the Walk of Fame.

The day will also include Lehi’s first annual Heritage Day from 3:00 pm - 7:00 pm. Heritage Day will highlight the history and heritage of Lehi Main Street with a walking tour with guides and displays along the buildings from Center Street through 400 West. The event will also include musical performances by fiddlers, the Miss Lehi Royalty, and Billy Brown and Friends.
