## *From Mayor Wilson*

### *The Value of Family*

This is similar to Lehi today. We have a lot of new people with new perspectives moving in. They may not be what we are used to, but they are all good folks. Who knows? Maybe we are the strange ones.

New schools are being constructed throughout the city, and that in itself is a blessing and a curse. Our youth continue to have great educational opportunities, but it also causes more traffic in low traffic areas. Lehi is working to widen roads and put in new sidewalks, which may mean more carpooling to keep our kids off the roads. We will all have to be patient until the dust settles and things get

completed. Patience is not easy, but we can all get through this great time of growth if we just put a little effort into it.

Water also continues to be an issue. We have a lot of water rights, we have put in new wells, and we have built a state of the art retention pond for irrigation water. We are trying to stay ahead of the growth. The real problem is not growth, but no snow or rain. Effective May 11, we will begin enforcing our water restrictions. We are asking each resident to take a look at the way they water and to abide by the ordinance. We will be sending a flier to each resident with information about conservation efforts. Pay attention and help us get through another year of little water.

Finally, let's drive a little slower in the subdivisions and on the streets, pay more attention to the road signs, and watch out for kids. I'm considering myself a kid because at my age you don't hear so well, you don't pay attention, and you can't see the picture on your driver's license. It doesn't matter the age but it does matter if we don't pay attention and hurt someone. Phone calls and texts can wait until we park the car. Families can still be families if we just keep the rules. No phone call or text is worth an accident.
