

## **Taylor Brothers Store-The First Store in Lehi From the Lehi Centennial History**

**Shortly after the abolishment of Camp Floyd, Thomas and William W. Taylor determined to go into the mercantile business for themselves. To their minds the growing population of Lehi was sufficient justification for the venture.**

**Obtaining a stock of goods, they began a mercantile business in a building erected on the corner of Main and Second West streets. This was the first real store in Lehi and the site of this initial venture has been in use by various companies since.**

**The mercantile of the store was obtained from Salt Lake City and because of the great cost of transporting most of it across the plains, the prices were necessarily high.**
