**JOB SUMMARY:** Performs a variety of **entry level skilled duties** related to the construction, installation, maintenance and repair of city water, wastewater, and storm drain systems.; May operate machinery to clean wastewater and storm drain systems.

**MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:** **Graduation from high school plus six months of experience** in general work experience . Previous experience with underground water systems, equipment placement, residential service locations, easements and right-of-way specifications is preferred; must have Utah CDL license; ability to lift a minimum of 50 pounds; ability to communicate verbally and in writing; skilled in operating various types of tools and power equipment to perform essential functions; Ability to develop effective working relationships with supervisor, subordinates and the public; will be required to pass a drug test and back ground check.

**Must obtain State Water Distribution Certification Level 1 within one year of hire.**

**RESPONSE TIME:** Employee must reside within 20 minutes of City Limits (based on average Google Maps drive time) for on-call purposes. Employee can take up to 6 months to relocate within appropriate response time area.
