(son of Isaac Allred and Mary Calvert). Born January 21, 1829, Farmington, Bedford county, Tennessee. Came to Utah July 24, 1847, Brigham Young company.

Married: Melissa Norton (daughter of David and Elizabeth Norton),
who was born in Indiana.
