

ETHEL SHOELL WEBB

Lehi Centennial History 1850-1950

Ethel Shoell Webb, daughter of Fredric C. and Margaret Wilson Shoell, was born October 20, 1905, in Pleasant Grove, Utah.

She was baptized a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, September 6, 1913. She attended grade and high schools in Pleasant Grove and graduated from a two year normal course at Brigham Young University, after which she taught school for five years in Lehi.

She taught Primary for three years and was on the Primary Stake Board for seven years. She also taught several Mutual Improvement Association classes and was a counselor in the Stake Young Women's Mutual Improvement Association. At the present time she is in the Second Ward Choir and is secretary of the Second Ward Relief Society.

She is a charter member of the Auctus Club which was organized in 1939.

June 20, 1929, after having taught school for four years, she was married to Armond E. Webb in the Salt Lake temple. They have been blessed with four children: Armond Paul, Keith Stanley, Margaret Ann, and Mark Ray.
