1850-1950 Centennial Biography

Florence Taylor Jones, daughter of James and Ann Rogers Taylor, was born in Lehi August 7, 1862.

When she was but a small child, she took part, along with all of her family, in some of the plays which were produced at the Lehi Playhouse.

She was married to Thomas Jones in 1883, by Bishop Cutler. Later when the Salt Lake Temple was finished, they went through and were sealed. She had eleven children, five boys and six girls, eight of whom survived. They are Marion J. Johnson, Florence J Firmage, Norma J. Nicholes, Verna J. McDonald, Alice Jones, Earl T., Clarence T., and Leland W. Jones.

Florence Jones spent her entire lifetime in Lehi. She was an extensive reader. In her later years, her grandsons loved to talk to her about the sports world. Among her many hobbies were growing flowers, and doing needle work. Mrs. Jones spent mjcn of her life in her home and with her family.
