(son of Stephen Weeks Ross and Jane Stevenson). Born April 12, 1841, Newark, New Jersey. Came to Utah fall of 1855, Jefferson Tidwell oxteam company.

Married: Ginevra Ellen Molen December 25, 1866, Lehi City, Utah (daughter of Jesse Molen and Lurany Huffaker of Illinois; pioneers 1847; [Jedediah M. Grant](#) company). She was born April 16, 1845.
