A snapshot from the Streets Division

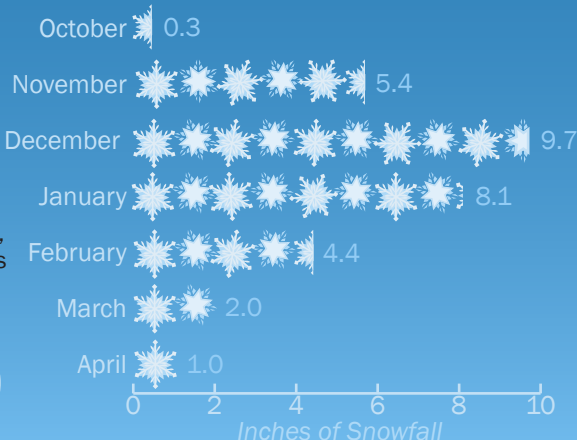
31 inches Average annual snowfall in Lehi over the last 30 years.

Record snowfall in a day in Lehi, January 17, 1906. **26 inches**

3,000 tons Lehi Streets Division uses, on average, 3,000 tons of salt per year for snow removal.

Per storm, Lehi Streets Division plows an average of **4,000 miles** of road.

Parking During a Snow Storm

According to Lehi City ordinance, parking on the street during a storm, or for 24 hours following a storm, is prohibited and may result in a parking ticket.

24 hours Number of hours following a storm that parking on the street is prohibited.

City-owned roads, with priority given to roads with the most traffic, followed by residential roads.
