SCHOOL FIELD TRIPS

School groups of between 20-100 students are invited to take a guided tour of the Hutchings Museum on school days between the hours of 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. During the two-hour tour, a guide gives presentations on museum artifacts and displays that relate to current school curriculum for students in the 3rd-5th grades. As time permits, students will also be given individual exploration time.

While the exhibits are tailored to the 3rd-5th grade curriculum, students of all ages are welcome to tour the museum.
