## NATIVE AMERICAN STUDIES

School groups of 80 students or less are invited to visit the Hutchings Museum to learn about Native American Studies. This field trip *does not* include a general tour of the museum. Students will learn about Native American life, food, legends, music, games, weapons, and more.

- Story Skins (ages 5 and older): \$1.00 - tell your story with pictographs.
