School groups will have a two hour natural history experience that includes 4-5 presentations.

Take a tour of the dinosaur, crocodile, and Ice Age exhibits and learn about Utah's surprising dinosaur and ice age history - a time when many animals typically found in Africa once roamed the state. Learn about ancient sharks and crocodiles that survived the great extinction. Come face to face with the skull of the biggest crocodile that ever lived and see fossil remains of prehistoric creatures.
