SUMMARY JOB DESCRIPTION: Performs a variety of technical, first-line supervisory duties related to coordinating and effecting power system installation, distribution, transmission, metering, and substation maintenance.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Graduation from High School or equivalent plus two (2) years of specialized training; AND six (6) years of general work experience performing similar duties; must be a certified journeyman power Lineman (BAT, IBEW, or IPSA) and maintain annual continuing education requirements; must possess a current, valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL/B), and have a good driving record; must be CPR trained; must reside within a 20-minute response time to be able to work an "on call" rotation and respond in emergency situations.
