Timpanogos Special Service District is now accepting green waste. We will be accepting those wastes as specified by the District in the past. However, we will not be accepting wastes which have been stored and have already begun the decomposition process. **WET GRASS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AS GREEN WASTE DISPOSAL.** Wet grass poses an increased odor and fire hazard potential, in addition to causing grinding equipment malfunctions. Wet leaves and garden wastes which pose an increased odor potential will not be accepted. Leaves in large quantities may also be rejected.

Other Prohibited Materials include:

Rocks	Cardboard	Dirt	Septage
Sod	Plastics	Metal	Rubber
Paper	Laminate	Glass	Trash
Tar Paper	Concrete	Tile	Ceramics

Rotting fruit/vegetables are discouraged. Sawdust in large quantities, and animal manure that are caked or wet and posing odor concerns, will not be accepted.

Acceptable Materials

Grass Clippings	Cornstalks/Vines
Wood Shavings	Dry Manure mixed with straw, etc.
Branches from trees/brushes	Straw
Leaves – dry	Hay
Bark	Clean Wood products

Grass clippings will be limited to 12 yards per week. Dry manure mixed with straw or other products will be accepted in small quantities.

Dirty loads containing trash and other undesirable materials will not be accepted. Stumps and roots with dirt and rocks are prohibited and logs or tree trunks over 6 feet long or larger than 30 inches in diameter will not be taken.
