As the weather gets warmer, the Senior Center gets busier! We'd love to have you join us this month for Classes, Outings, Game Day, and more as we SPRING into fun!



Prizes are available for participants. Please have a current Senior Center Membership to participate.



On the 4th Friday of the month (unless otherwise noted), we have a small birthday celebration for all those who had a birthday during the month!














GOOD TO KNOW



Dealing with Dementia

The four-hour course provides caregivers with effective strategies for dealing with dementia behaviors. Using Dealing with Dementia: A Caregiver's Guide, the training teaches caregivers how to find answers and resources. This resource helps caregivers with new skills and tools, as well as introduces them to a caregiver group. A few of the skills that Dealing with Dementia can provide are problem solving, as well as self-care for the caregivers.




