On September 11th, people across the country come together to honor the memory of the tragic events of 9/11 by engaging in acts of kindness and service that uplift their communities. This day has become a National Day of Service that reflects the resilience and unity of the American spirit.

Last year Lehi City partnered with Lehi Serves organization for the first

city-wide 9/11 Day of Service. The turnout was astonishing. Residents and community leaders of all ages and abilities came together to serve their community and people across the world. Nearly 1000 volunteers donated 1600 hours of service to multiple projects to help beautify our city parks and assisted in a variety of other charitable efforts and organizations, including Stitching Hearts International, Tiny Tim's Foundation, and Lifting Hands International. In true Lehi fashion, our residents showed inspiring examples of neighborly love.

Volunteer efforts included prepping 1000 toy cars, 300 thank you notes to first responders, more than 40 trees planted, 12 picnic tables refurnished, 50 ft of fencing and posts removed, and 120 kits for refugees.

The next National Day of Service is Saturday, September 9th. We encourage all our residents to join the volunteer efforts available in the community. We hope to double the number of volunteers this year and share in the spirit of serving.

This month we begin our Fall After-School Reading & Math Session on September 6 and 7. This session runs through November 14. Our Fall/Winter ABC Session began last month and will continue until December 14. After-School programs offer reading and math classes for Lehi students in K - 4th grade. Classes are 45 minutes twice a week Monday/Wednesday OR Tuesday/Thursday. Class times are 3 p.m., 4 p.m., and 5 p.m. This program has 4 sessions throughout the year.
