

RESOLUTION NO: 2023-71

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS CERTIFYING THE OFFICIAL CANVASSERS' REPORT OF THE NOVEMBER 21, 2023 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION FOR LEHI CITY, UTAH.

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2023, a General Municipal Election for Lehi City, Utah was held to elect three City Council candidates; and

WHEREAS, this election was conducted by Lehi City through vote by mail and administered by Utah County using Ranked Choice Voting as allowed by UCA 20A-4-6 Municipal Alternate Voting Methods Pilot Project. Those results pertaining specifically to Lehi City's municipal election are included in this official canvass report.

WHEREAS, UCA 20A-4-301(2) provides as follows:

- 2(a) The Mayor and the municipal legislative body are the board of municipal canvassers for the municipality.
- (b) The board of municipal canvassers shall meet to canvass the returns at the usual place of meeting of the municipal legislative body:
 - (i) for canvassing of returns from a municipal primary election, no sooner than seven days after the election and no later than 14 days after the election;
- (c) Attendance of a simple majority of the municipal legislative body shall constitute a quorum for conducting the canvass.

The official results are attached as Exhibit A

City Council Candidates Paige Albrecht, Michelle Stallings and Heather Newall received more than 50% of the valid rankings counted per seat for this General Municipal Election, and are hereby declared duly elected for the office of City Council, for a term of four years.
