SELF DEFENSE PROGRAM

The Rape Aggression Defense (R.A.D.) System is a program of realistic self-defense tactics and techniques for women only. It is a comprehensive course that begins with awareness, prevention, risk reduction and avoidance, while progressing on to the basics of hands-on defense training. This class ends with a dynamic simulation giving the student an opportunity to practice their skills. This course is taught by nationally certified R.A.D. Instructors and provides each student with a workbook/reference manual. This manual outlines the entire Physical Defense Program for reference and continuous personal growth, and is the key to our free lifetime return and practice policy for R.A.D. graduates.

This class is being hosted by the Lehi City Police Department and will take place in the Broadbend Community Room, located at 128 North 10 East, Lehi.
