HOW TO VOTE	
Early Voting	Early Voting will be held at the Health and Justice Building located at 151 S. University, Suite 1600 Provo, UT 84606, Weekdays October 28 to November 4, 8am to 5pm. Also open Saturday, November 2, 10am to 3pm. Voter Registration is also available , must bring valid ID and proof of residency to register and vote.
Vote By Mail- Drop Box	Once you fill out and sign your ballot envelope, take it to one of the 28 drop boxes located throughout Utah County. Lehi's is in front of the Public Safety Building, on the south side. Closes on Election Day at 8 p.m. https://vote.utahcounty.gov/voting-locations
Vote By Mail- US Postal Service	A stamp is not required. Ballot must be postmarked on or before November 4th (day before the election) It's best to watch the postmaster postmark your ballot to ensure that it is marked on time.
Vote Center- On Election Day	Lehi Broadbent Room, 7 a.m.- 8 p.m., or any Utah County Vote Center, https://vote.utahcounty.gov/voting-locations
